

Dr. Eric Favaro is respected nationally and internationally as an innovator and advocate for effective programs in Arts Education. Trained as a music educator, Eric taught instrumental and classroom music in Calgary and in Cape Breton. He served as Arts Education Consultant with the Cape Breton-Victoria Regional School Board, and recently retired as Arts Education Consultant with the Nova Scotia Department of Education. He publishes frequently and continues to work on curriculum committees and other projects through provincial Ministries of Education and Federal agencies. Eric served as president of the Nova Scotia Music Educators' Association from 1993-95, and president of the Canadian Music Educators' Association from 1995-97. He initiated and chaired the first National Symposium on Arts Education (Cape Breton, 1997), and served on the board for the International Society for Music Education from 2000-04.
